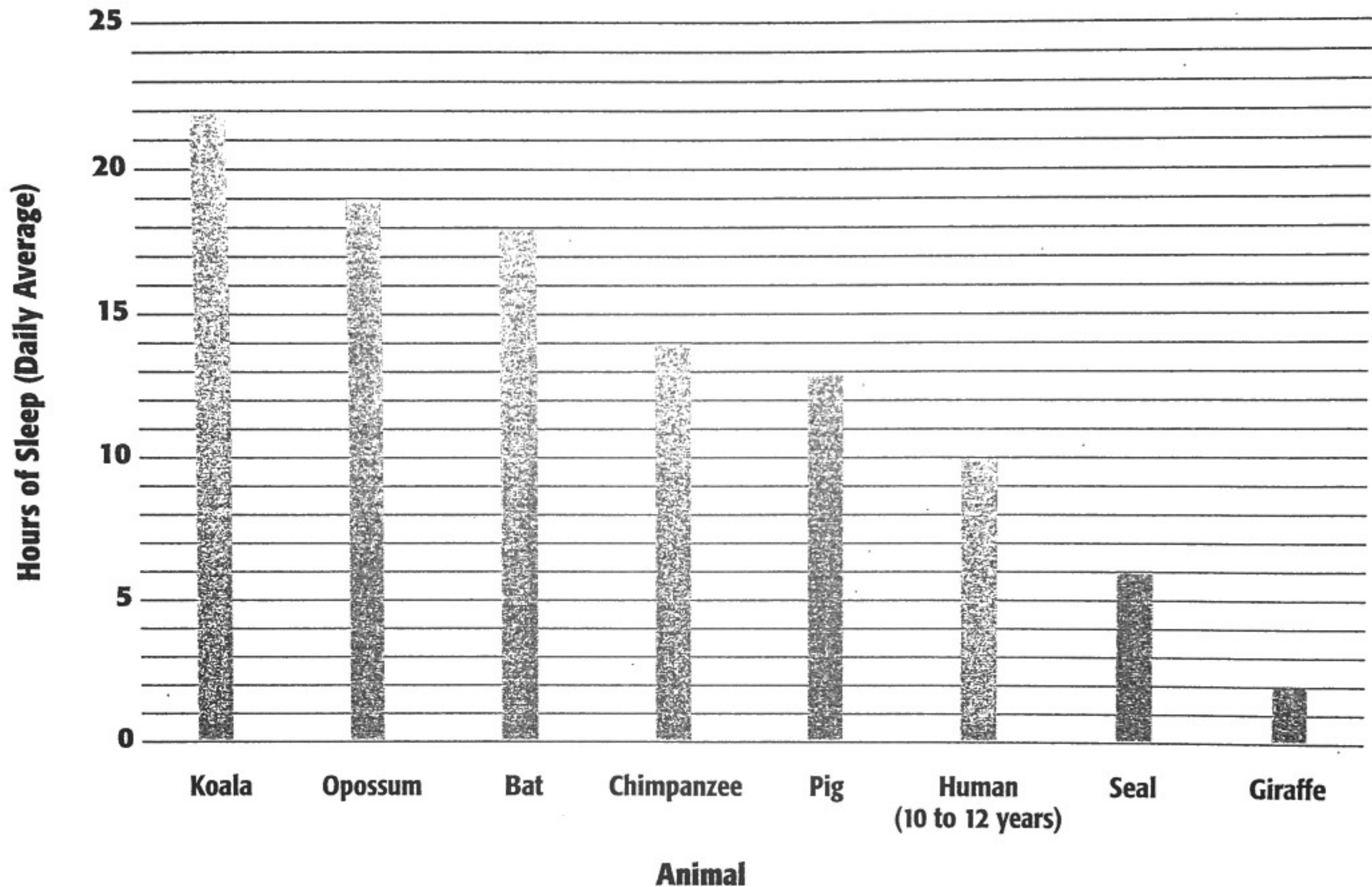


It's Naptime . . . Again?

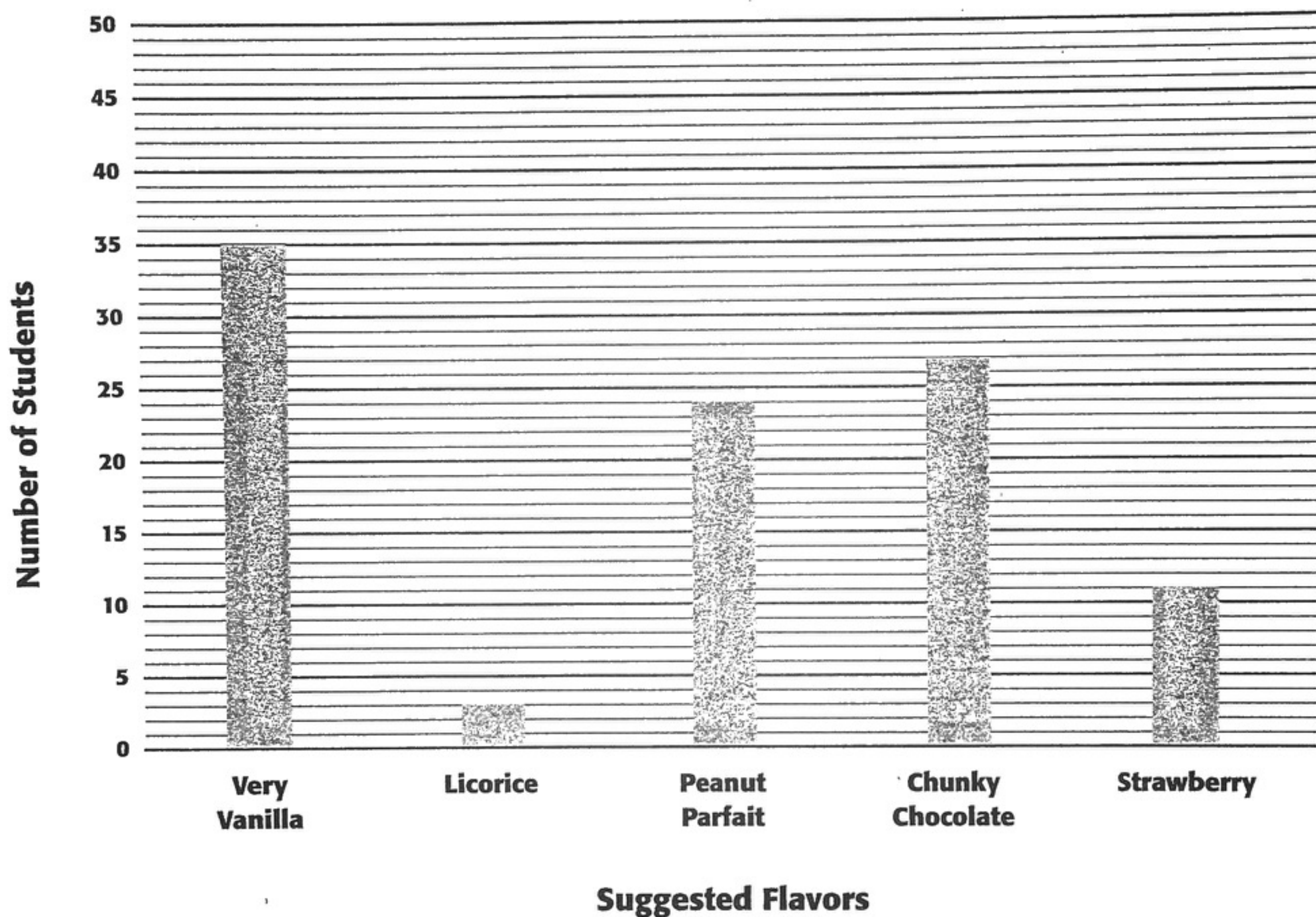
